Letters from Shungnak, Alaska to his nephew William Asquith, Sunderland, England, 1912-1936.

Primarily letters from Lewis Lloyd in Shungnak, Alaska to his nephew William Asquith in Sunderland, England; also contains photographs, a map, and letter from J.P. Asquith. 1965. containing background information and a diagram of family relationships. Lewis and Ella Lloyd describe their activities, village life, and their adopted Eskimo child, Jennie Anauok(?)

1. Letter to Mrs. Leibowitz, State of Alaska Education Department, Dec. 31, 1965, written by J.P. Asquith in Essex, England about his family; included is a family diagram. 5 pp, holograph.
2. Letter of Nov. 19, 1915 to nephew [William Asquith] from Lewis Lloyd; includes his Notary Public seal of the Territory of Alaska. 2 pp, holograph.
3. Letter of June 16, 1913 to nephew [William A.] from Lewis Lloyd. 2 pp, holograph.
4. Letter of Sept. 18, 1916 to nephew [W.A.] from Lewis Lloyd, plus blue envelope. 1 p, typewritten.
5. Letter of Dec. 15, 1916 to nephew [W.A.] from L.L., plus blue envelope. 3pp, holograph.

6. Letter with pencil note at top "In Dec. 1933 envelope." To Will and family, from Aunt Ella. Both sides of small sheet, originally folded in half, holograph.
7. Letter of Dec. 5, 1933 to Nephew William from uncle Lewis and Aunty Ella, Lloyd, plus envelope. 1 p, typewritten.
8. Letter of Jan. 31, 1936 to Our Dear Nephew William, unsigned, but envelope says Lewis Lloyd. [Note at bottom says (over), but nothing on verso.] 1 p, typewritten.
9. Letter with pencil note at top "In envelope with Jan. 31, 1936 letter." To Minnie and Little Phil from Aunt Ella. 1 p, holograph.
10. Letter of Feb. 13, 1966 to Mrs. Leibowitz from J.P. Asquith, plus blue envelope. Also enclosed are two photographs. One is a blurry view of an older woman and man posed formally, addressed to Sister Dora and signed Brother Lewis and Sister Ella (neg. # 01-436b). The other is labeled Lewis Lloyd and is a clearer head & shoulders portrait of the same man, younger (neg. #01-436a). 1 pp, holograph.
